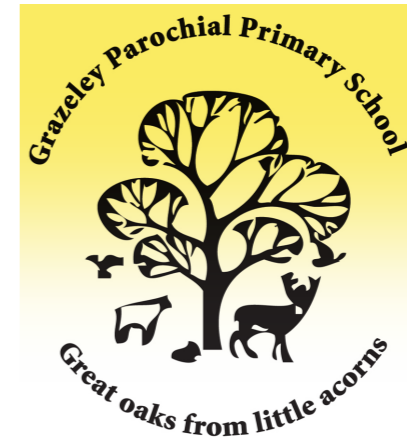

# **Year 3**

### General organisation and skills

- Able to leave parents/carers in playground
- Responsible for bringing in reading book and record, letters, homework and PE bags
- Organised and ready to learn in time for the register
- Remember to use the toilet at break and lunch times
- Know what they are having for lunch each day
- Able to use a knife and fork and sit whilst eating
- Able to tie their own laces if wearing them (including football boots)
- Hang their own bags and coats onto pegs
- Aware of their responsibility to care for themselves, their equipment and each other
- Able to cut a paper outline accurately using scissors
- Change their reading book independently
- Have regularly experienced trips to the library

### Learning Behaviours

- Able to listen attentively to each other and all adults and respond appropriately
- Able to write the date and a title
- Able to use a ruler to measure to the nearest centimetre and to draw lines accurately, using existing lines in books
- Able to use an index to find a key word in a non-fiction book

### Curriculum

- Able to tell the time to the nearest quarter hour
- Recognise all coinage, £5, £10
- Know and quickly recall the 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Able to spell the names of days and months
- Know most Year 2 common exception words
- Write a simple narrative or recount
- Read most common exception words for Year 2
- Beginning to read to the level of White band
- Understand and answer questions about what they have read
