TERMS OF REFERENCE



Statement:

The Governing Body takes a strategic role, act as a critical friend to the school and be accountable for its decisions. It should set aims, objectives and review, agree and monitor policies, targets and priorities. Governing Body meetings will not be open to the public. Minutes of meetings are available, except for matters considered confidential.

The Governing Body has the following core strategic functions:

Establish the strategic direction by:

- Setting the vision, values and objectives for the school.
- Agreeing the school development strategy with priorities and targets
- Meeting statutory duties

Ensuring accountability by:

- Appointing the Headteacher
- Monitoring progress towards targets
- Performance managing the Headteacher
- Engaging with stakeholders
- Contributing to school self-evaluation

Ensuring financial probity:

- Approving the budget
- Monitoring spending against the budget
- Ensuring value for money is obtained
- Ensuring risks to the organisation are managed.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Governing Body will undertake the above functions by:

Hold at least 4 meetings each year.

Appoint a Clerk

Elect a Chair and Vice Chair. These appointments will be made annually. A Chair must not act for more than 6 consecutive years.

Advise all parents of any parent governor vacancies, all staff of any staff governor vacancies and to recruit and appoint all foundation governors.

Set dates of meetings for the year ahead.

Receive, review and challenge as appropriate on the Headteacher reports

Review and monitor school, Local Authority and National results.

Review the level of exclusions

Monitor attendance of pupils, staff and governors.

Be responsible for Health and Safety

Monitor accidents/incidents involving pupils, staff, governors and visitors.

Review, adopt and monitor a Fol Policy

If required, consider the suspension of a governor.

Set pupil performance targets

Provide induction for new governors

Encourage governors to visit school and to review, adopt and monitor a governors visit policy and feedback procedure

Review, adopt and monitor the procedures for dealing with complaints from parents/carers.

Review, monitor and approve the School Development Plan

Set the overall long term strategy for the school

Review, monitor and adopt a risk management policy and strategy. To regularly review the risk appetite statement. To monitor and review risks in conjunction with the Headteacher.

Ensure that at least 2 governors are appointed to complete the Headteachers Performance Management.

Maintain and annually update a file of Business/Pecuniary Interest declarations

Review, adopt and monitor a governors expense policy

Review and monitor the curriculum

Review annually the delegation of functions and committee structure

Organise support and training for governors.

To receive a regular report on Safeguarding

Approve the Annual Budget

Review of 3-5 year budget forecasts

Authorisation of statement of internal control

Appointment of Headteacher and Deputy Headteacher

Monitor and review progress and support of all pupil groups
