

## **INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT**

1. The name of the school is Grazeley Parochial Church of England (Aided) Primary School

The school is a voluntary aided school.

2. The name of the governing body is 'The governing body of Grazeley Parochial Church of England (Aided) Primary School'

3. The governing body shall consist of:

Two Parent Governors  
One Head teacher  
One LA Governor  
One Staff Governor  
Seven Foundation Governors

4. The total number of governors shall be 12, except that, at any time when the head teacher has given written notice to the clerk to the governors that s/he does not wish to be a governor, the total shall be 11.

5. Six foundation governors shall be appointed as follows:

Two by Spencers Wood and Grazeley Parochial Church Council  
Four by the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education

- 6(a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The Team Rector of Loddon Reach

- 6(b). The Archdeacon of Berkshire shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in 6(a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations, or when there is a vacancy in the office named in 6(a) above.

- 6(c) The Archdeacon of Berkshire shall be entitled to request the removal of the ex officio foundation governor named in 6(a) above and to appoint a substitute foundation governor.

7. The school was founded by a Trust dated 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1862.

8. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at Parish and Diocesan levels.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

9. This instrument of government comes into effect on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020.
10. This instrument was made by order of Wokingham Local Authority on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2021
11. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
