<u>Car Park</u> The feedback is that the slight change to the timings at the end of school has improved the situation in the car park. <u>Communication</u> Yellow slips/wristbands - Please could the process for issuing them be clarified.	The school is in the process of purchasing a medical tracker which is an online resource where accidents are logged and details emailed to parents. This will be rolled out in due course.

Photos will be uploaded on the school newsletter and/or Google classroom.
Website - is the school website being updated? Some sections are out of date/missing information.	The website has been updated.
<u>School Lunches/Snacks</u>
