- Know what is a good behaviour choice at school
- Families are all different.
- We all have different ethnicities
- Know the members of their immediate family and the relationship to them, name and describe people who are familiar to them.
- A friend is someone who I like to spend time with.
- How to make friends and share with friends.
- Harvest time is a time when we share our food with people in our community who need help
- We are a loving community

### **Key Knowledge:**


- There are adults in our community who help us.
