This seasonal project provides opportunities for outdoor learning and allows children to observe how the local area changes in the summer, and learn how to stay safe in the sun.

This project teaches children about the global community to which they belong and explores how living things, communities and climates differ around the world.

### Key Knowledge:

- Recognise signs of Summer
- Identify plants in the natural world around us in summer.
- Observe how animals' behaviour changes with the season.
- Observe and recognise signs of summer.
- It is important to wear sun cream, sun hats and drink plenty of water to keep hydrated on hot sunny days.
- To know how to keep safe at the seaside

### Key Knowledge:

- People live in and visit lots of different places around the world.
- Globes and maps can show us the location of different places around the world.
- Climates and environments are different, depending on their location on Earth.
- We are part of a global community.
- Heritage is a person's unique, inherited sense of family identity, including the values, traditions, culture and artefacts handed down by previous generations.
- To know that India is a country & know some facts about it.
- Different countries around the world have different habitats, plants and animals.
- Camouflage is an animal's natural colouring or pattern that enables it to blend in with its surroundings.
- Carnivores are animals that eat other animals, Herbivores are animals that eat plants, Omnivores are animals that eat plants and other animals.
- Identify Mammals (animals that breathe air, have warm blood and give birth to live babies, Reptiles (animals that breathe air, have dry, scaly skin and lay eggs, & Birds (animals that breathe air, have beaks and feathers and lay eggs.)
